Newsbrief

President Md. Abdul Hamid asked the deputy Commissioners to remain watchful to prevent abuse of power while discharging their respective duties as the district co-coordinator and supervisor of the multi-faceted activities of the government. The President told the DCs as they gathered at the Bangabhaban on the third day of the 'DC Conference-2023' in Dhaka yesterday.

Swiss Ambassador in Dhaka Nathalie Chuard paid a farewell call on President Md. Abdul Hamid at Bangabhaban in Dhaka yesterday. During the meeting, the President wished Nathalie Chuard a bright future, President's Press Secretary Md. Joynal Abedin said to the journalists later. The Head of the State sought continuous cooperation from Switzerland in the economic development and expansion of trade and commerce in Bangladesh.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina said digital connectivity would be the key equipment to transform the country into a Smart Bangladesh. The Premier said this in a video message aired at the inaugural ceremony of the Digital Bangladesh Fair-2023 at the Bangabandhu International Conference Centre in Dhaka yesterday.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina said the government is taking all kinds of preparations to hold the country's next general election in a free and fair manner. She said while outgoing Switzerland Ambassador Nathalie Chuard called on her at her Sangsad Bhaban office in Dhaka yesterday.

Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader said evil forces will not be allowed to play with fire in the country. He told a meeting of the AL's Mymensingh divisional representatives at the party's Bangabandhu Avenue central office in Dhaka yesterday.

Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal said, that law enforcers will work to ensure holding the national election in a free, fair and acceptable manner. The Minister said to the journalists after a meeting with deputy commissioners on the sixth working day of the DCs conference in Dhaka yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Dr. Hasan Mahmud gave directives to the deputy commissioners to take immediate steps to prevent the spread of rumours and fake information through unregistered portals and social platforms. The Minister disclosed this to reporters while replying to a query after exchanging views with the DCs on the last day of the three-day Deputy Commissioner Conference at Osmani Memorial Auditorium in Dhaka yesterday.
