**Newsbrief**

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is expected to inaugurate 25 projects with involvement of around Taka 1,316.97 crore during her daylong visit to Rajshahi tomorrow. The Premier is also likely to lay foundation stones of six other projects with an estimated cost of around Taka 376.28 crore. According to the official sources in Dhaka yesterday, the implemented projects include Mural of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader said, the movement of BNP-led alliance is running with the invisible command of remote control. He told this at a joint meeting, arranged with the Awame League Central leaders, the presidents and general secretaries of Dhaka North and South City units of the AL and the party's affiliated organisations at the AL's central office at Bangabandhu Avenue in Dhaka yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Dr. Hasan Mahmud said, BNP has run out of breath and now chose the path of road march programme. He said this while replying to journalists after visiting Madrasha ground in Rajshahi yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Anisul Huq said, the next Parliament Election would be held as per the Constitution. The Minister also said, any political party in a democratic country can carry out any political activities. He said this to the journalists at Akhaura Rail Station In Dhaka yesterday.

Posts and Telecommunications Minister Mustafa Jabbar said, the government is working to build a 'Smart Bangladesh', announced by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. The Minister said this while addressing a discussion on the fifth industrial revolution and 5G infrastructures: Bangladesh's Preparation' on the second day of the Digital Bangladesh Fair, organised by the Posts and Telecommunications Division at the Bangabandhu International Conference Center in Dhaka, according to a press release yesterday.

State Minister for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Nasrul Hamid said, science practice must be increased at large scale to reap the benefits of the 4th Industrial Revolution. He said this while addressing at the inauguration of 14th DRMC-Summit National Science Carnival-2023 at Residential Model College in Dhaka yesterday.

He said this while addressing an award and reception programme of 12-day long Chalanbil Education Function-2023 in Singra, Natore yesterday.
