Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader said, BNP made Hero Alam candidate in the by-polls to Bogura to undermine the Jatiya Sangsad. He said, while addressing a peace rally at Kamrangirchar Government Hospital ground yesterday. Dhaka City South AL arranged the peace rally against BNP-Jamaat's terrorism, militancy, anarchy, ill-politics and anti-state conspiracy.
