## Newsbrief

A number of agreements and Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) are likely to be signed between Dhaka and Bangkok during the upcoming visit of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to Thailand from April 24 to 29, the Foreign Ministry said yesterday.

Meanwhile, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina laid emphasis on ensuring food and nutrition security calling upon the private sector to step forward for the development of the country's poultry, fisheries and livestock sectors. The Prime Minister said this while addressing the opening ceremony of the Livestock Services Week and Exhibition-2024 at the old Trade Fair Ground in capital's Sher-e-Banglanagar yesterday. The Premier also visited the exhibition as the Department of Livestock and Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries organised it.

Awami League (AL) General Secretary and Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader condemned and protested the "false, fabricated and politically motivated" statements of BNP. The Minister said this in a statement yesterday. The Minister said, BNP is patronizing arson terrorists. On the other hand, they allege that the government is suppressing the opposition party when the law enforcers take legal actions against the terrorists, the Minister added.

Environment, Forest, and Climate Change Minister Saber Hossain Chowdhury said, the Bangladesh government is going to form Bangladesh Climate Development Partnership (BCDP). The Minister told at a consultation with development partners on BCDP at Hotel Intercontinental in the capital yesterday. The Minister said this while speaking at the inauguration ceremony of a state-of-the art factory dedicated to produce AAC Blocks and Panel at Jagir area under the ownership of Max Group in Manikganj yesterday.

Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC) Mayor Md. Atiqul Islam has announced to launch month-long awareness-raising programme from April 22. The Mayor said this while addressing a coordination meeting on "conducting a month-long campaign for prevention of dengue" with all ward Councilors and officials concerned on the virtual platform on Wednesday, an official handout said yesterday.

Bangladesh and India would further accelerate cooperation in the areas of information, media, film and television and significantly promote the people-to-people relations between the two neighboring countries.
